2025 Princess Tournament Average Rule Updated

5. Entering Average: Minimum of 21 Games

A. 2023-2024 USBC Highest Average or Sport's Average it will be converted

B. Highest 2023-2024 or 2022-2023 average of all USBC leagues (minimum of 21 games).

C. If none, then use a current single USBC league average (minimum of 21 games) winter and summer as of tournament date. League sheets for all leagues or bowl.com printout must be provided). The bowler is responsible to verify the accuracy of her averages.

D. Bowlers with neither of the above averages must bowl scratch (210).

E. If current season average for at least 21 games at the time of bowling exceeds last season's average by 10 or more pins, current season average must be used (Rule 319a-2).

F. Reporting of previous tournament winnings will apply (Rule 319d).

G. The average adjustment rule will apply (Rule 319e).

H. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their own average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. Failure to use the correct average may disqualify the score if submitted average is lower than correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicaps. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average, if it is higher than the correct average (Rule 319a-3).

Note: This means NO Standard Composite Averages will be used to determine the average of the bowler. COMPOSITE AVERAGES has created a lot of confusion as to which average to use. Therefore, it has been removed.
