

To be eligible for nomination as a director the candidate must be an active member of a local bowling association for two years or more.

The candidate must have served as an officer or director of a local 500 club for at least two years.

A candidate must be a member of a local 500 club

The candidate must be an active participant of a California United States Bowling Congress Association (CALUSBC) certified league during the current season.

The candidate must not be bowling in an uncertified league.

A candidate must be a member of the California Women's 500 Club at the time of election and throughout her term of office.

A candidate to be eligible for nomination as line officer of the state 500 club shall have served one complete term of office on the board of directors during the two year period preceding the nomination or be a member emeriti of the California Women's 500 Club provided the candidate meets the qualifications, if any, prescribed for the office she seeks.

Emergency Clause:

If candidate is unable to attend the annual meeting due to illness or emergency (approved by the board) their qualifications will be submitted on the ballot if the president has been fully informed of said emergency.
